- What's the capital of Scotland? Edinburgh
- What's the biggest city in Scotland? Glasgow
- How many people live in Scotland? about 5 million in 2014 and 5.5 million in 2019
- Which Scottish lake has its own monster? Loch Ness

Scottish history

- Who is Scotland's old enemy? the English
- Is Scotland part of the UK or is it an independent country? part of UK
- What are the colours of the Scottish flag? blue and white
- What's the symbol of Scotland? the thistle (Distel)

Scottish life

- What languages do people speak in Scotland? English, Gaelic, Scots
- What sports are special to Scotland? football, golf, shinty, Highland games
(e.g. tossing the camber)
- What's special about the Scots' national dress? kilts look like skirts and are
originally from Ireland
- What's the most famous Scottish instrument? bagpipe
- In the referendum in 2014, the majority of people (55.3%) voted against leaving the UK.
